Since Anansi has moved from being an elementary school to now being a K-8, the faculty and governance council worked to update the vision and mission for the school. The new vision statement for Anansi Charter School is: “To be a public community school that educates the heart and mind of each learner to ensure success.” “The mission of Anansi Charter School is to develop the academic potential and emotional

intelligence of each learner.
