All work provided is an opportunity for your child to continue to practice their skills to support their retention of skills taught at school. Picking up work at school:

If you are needing to pick up hard copies of work that has been assigned by your child's teacher, I will offer a pick up at school on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday this week. **Please call me in the office at 575-776-2256 X3, just before you arrive so that I can bring your work to you in the car so that we are maintaining the needed distancing.**

You will receive an email from your child's various teachers that will outline their plan for communication with you. Their role will be to support you and your child through learning opportunities and resources that you can carry out at home.
