**Congratulations! Anansi Charter Earns an A:** Anansi earned in an A on the school report card provided by the New Mexico Public Education Department. The report card reflects student achievement on the PARCC assessment, the growth students make on the PARCC assessment, input from students' and parents' surveys regarding teacher instruction, and student attendance. This grade is earned and owned by the students and faculty, and supported by parents. Congratulations to all, we had a great year! Anansi is the top performing school in the greater Taos area.

**Turn in Your Summer Reading Log:** In the spring we sent out our summer reading bags with all of our students; which included a book to read, a reading log, and booklists to help you find books to read. Turn in your log by Friday, September 7<sup>th</sup> and your child will receive earned prizes at Back to School Night. We are still hoping that parents can find the reading bags and books that were given to the students last May. We would like to have these bags for use each year, a big thanks to all who returned their books, bags, and logs.

**Back to School Night:** Please plan to attend Back to School night along with your child, our goal is for 100% attendance and participation. A portion of the evening is spent enjoying hands on activities so that your child can guide you through experiences that happen in the classroom and part of the time is teacher presentation and question and answer for parents. This is an important event to learn about the year's instructional goals, homework policies, schedules, and each grade level curricular overview. Back to School Night is scheduled for Wednesday September 12<sup>th</sup> for grades K-5 and Thursday, September 13<sup>th</sup> for grades 6-8. Kindergarten through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade will meet from 5-6pm and the 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grade will meet from 6-7pm. The middle school meeting will meet from 5:30-6:30pm.

1<sup>st</sup> Family Let's Move Event: The Friends of Anansi sponsor three family oriented activities per school year and the first one is the hike to Williams Lake. The purpose of the hike is to bring our school families together to socialize, get some physical activity together, and enjoy the outdoors. Families should meet in the parking lot for the William's Lake Trailhead above Taos Ski Valley at 10am, there will be signs and a meet and greet committee to launch the hike. Families can choose to picnic at the lake, or they may choose to shorten the hike and come back to picnic, play outdoor games, and socialize near the trailhead. **Field Trips:** The kindergarten through second grade students will be taking their annual fall hike field trip on Friday, September 21<sup>st</sup> If you are able to join your child for this fun trip, please let your classroom teacher know. There will also be field trips this fall to support the fall arts and their studies of New Mexico history and culture.
